1. P. I'm Dave = **My** name is Dave (**Mein** Name)
2. P. You're Olivia = **Your** name is Olivia (**Dein** Name )  
You're Mrs Rausch = **Your** name is Mrs R. (**Ihr** Name) (**höflichkeitsform**)
3. P. He's Luke = **His** name is Luke (**Sein** Name)  
She's Holly = **Her** name is Holly (**Ihr** Name)  
It's a park = **Its** trees are big (**Seine** Bäume) (**Sache**)

Plural

1. P. We're Pia and Holly = **Our** names are Pia and Holly  
(**Unsere** Namen)
2. P. You're Pia and Holly = **Your** names are Pia and Holly  
(**Euere** Namen)  
You're Mr and Mrs Elliot. = **Your** names are Mr and Mrs Elliot.  
(**Ihre** Namen)
3. P. They're Luke and Jamie = **Their** names are Luke and Jamie.  
(**Ihre** Namen)
